POSITION: Production Engineer

Sunshine is a Calgary based public corporation, listed on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange since March 1, 2012. The Company is focused on the development of its significant holdings of oil sands leases in the Athabasca oil sands region. Sunshine owns interests in oil sands and petroleum and natural gas leases in the Athabasca region of Alberta. The Company is currently focused on executing milestone undertakings in the West Ells project area. West Ells has an initial production target rate of 5,000 barrels per day

This is a full-time, permanent position based out of Sunshine Oilsands Ltd.'s main office in Calgary. This position requires working in the field on a regular base. Time off in lieu will be provided if required to work above regular office hours with approval from the Manager.

JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The incumbent will report to the Manager, Production & Development.

Responsibilities of this role include, but are not limited to:

- Analysis and review of steam injection and return rates, down hole and surface temperatures and pressures of all instrumentation during production.
- Provide directives to Operations on rate, pressure, temperature targets to optimize the performance of wells.
- Review the well test data and verification of the validity of the data.
- Coordinating the fluid samples collection with Operations and analysis at designated labs.
- Coordination between Production and Operations teams.
- Assist in troubleshooting issues with instrumentation in production, source water, observation wells and other monitoring devices.
- Monitor artificial lift performance during SAGD operations.
- Assist with production accounting reporting, reconciliation, plant inventory and balances.
- Other duties as required.

REQUIRED EXPERIENCE AND SKILL SET:

- An engineering degree from an accredited university.
- Registration with APEGA.
- Minimum of 1-5 years of industry-related experience, preferably in SAGD and thermal operations.
- Strong analytical skills and the ability to work and contribute in a team environment.
- Good verbal and written communication skills.
